WACEM Leader Dr. Ayman El-Menyar presented the results of his landmark Study titled "Inflammatory Cytokines Response and Head Injury Biomarkers: Interim Analysis of a Prospective, Randomized Controlled Clinical Trial of Early Administration of Beta Blocker in Traumatic Brain Injury" at the 23rd European Congress of Trauma and Emergency Surgery (ECTES) in Lisbon, Portugal held from 28-30 April 2024.

The study is being conducted at the World Renowned Hamad Medical Corporation , Qatar and is led by Dr. El-Menyar and the Hamad trauma Center team.

The Study Investigates the impact of early beta-blockers (BB) administration on the adrenergic surge, inflammatory cytokines, and TBI biomarkers based on the HsTnT status in TBI patients with varying severities.

Dr. El-Menyar was awarded the best oral presentation for ECTS2024.

He is a mentor for medical students and residents and has been awarded three research grants from Qatar Foundation, along with two internal grants from HMC. He is a member of many international societies, including the European Heart Rhythm Association, European Society of Cardiology/Acute Cardiac Care, Heart Gulf Association Society, and Egyptian Society of Cardiology. He is a Fellow of the American College of Cardiology (FACC) and the European Society of Cardiology (FESC).
