

WACEM21 WoWs The World !!


India Hosted WACEM21 virtually to coincide with the celebrations of Azadi ka Amrit Mohotsav as India completes 75 Years of Independence.


Spanning over 10 Days across various time zones of the world WACEM21 featured talks from Star Academicians working in Emergency Sciences.




